THROW ONE BACK



Gameplay:

Player begins by making a Blackjack ante and the optional bonus Throw One Back wager at equal amounts.

The Throw One Back bet is resolved using the player's first two cards according to the posted pay table.

How it works:

If the player hits a hard 12-16 versus a dealer up card of 7 or higher and busts, the player can throw one card back (not the bust card) and play the new hand versus the dealer.

Wagers are then resolved per standard Blackjack rules:

Winning wagers pay 1:1, ties push.

Example:

Player has a 10 and a 2 and hits, but busts with a 10 versus a dealer 7

Player then throws back the 2 and now has a 20

Dealer has a 10,7 - which is topped by player's 20

Player Wins 1:1
